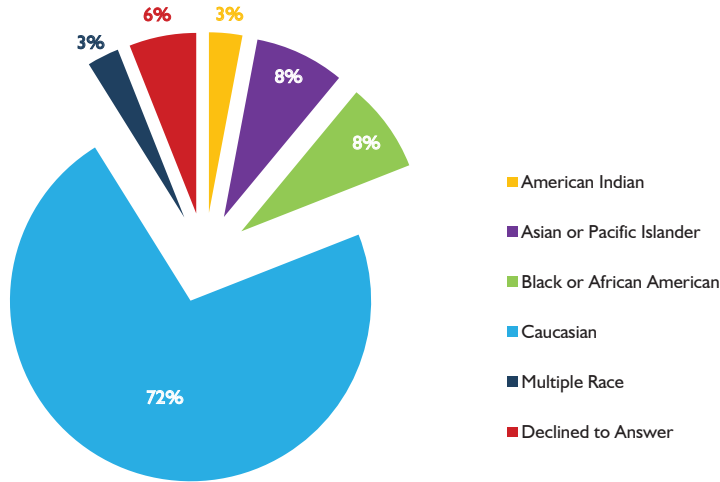
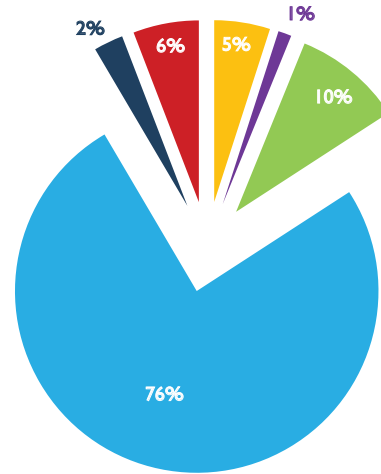

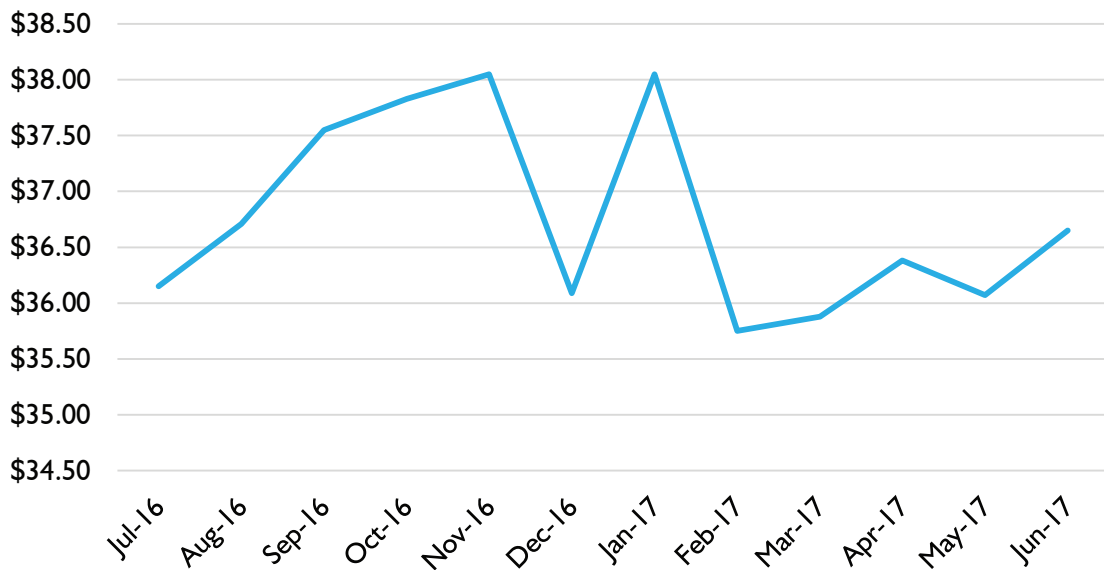
IP Race Breakdown

As of June 2017, 4,430 businesses participate in Insure Oklahoma. ESI and IP cover 19,517 lives.

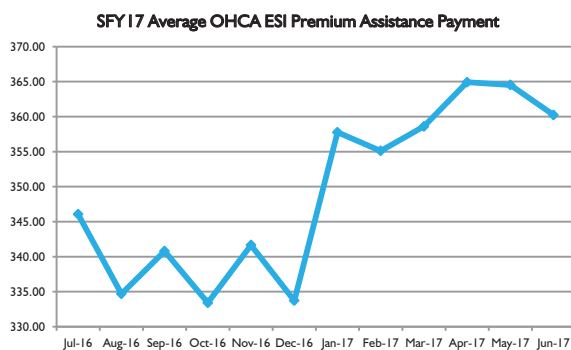
INSURE OKLAHOMA: PREMIUM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Insure Oklahoma (IO) was implemented under the federal Health Insurance Flexibility and Accountability waiver, and it is a unique product in Oklahoma designed to bridge the healthcare gap for low-income working adults. The program is funded by the state's tobacco tax and matched with federal dollars. The Employer-Sponsored Insurance (ESI) plan assists eligible business owners, employees and their dependents with health insurance premiums. Individuals who do not qualify for ESI may be eligible for IO through the Individual Plan (IP), which is the state sponsored health plan operated under the Medicaid program.

Basic requirements for both programs are:

- working Oklahoma resident
- U.S. citizen or legal alien
- ages 19 through 64
- not enrolled in SoonerCare, Medicare or any commercial plan
